A national and international trainer and lecturer, Lt. Mark Wynn has served as an advisor to state, national and international leaders and helped guide and shape law and policy domestic and sexual violence issues. He is also a key creator of the largest police domestic violence investigative unit in the United States.

A decorated 21-year member of the Nashville Metropolitan Police Department, he served as Lieutenant to the Domestic Violence Division and was a member of the Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) team for 15 years. He was also selected as one of the top 10 police officers in the United States by the International Association of Chiefs of Police and Parade Magazine in 1995.

In 2012, he received the Family Justice Center Alliance Lifetime Achievement Award.

As a police officer, detective, educator, program supervisor, consultant and advisor, Lt. Wynn's work is devoted to ending family violence.
